Rules on CFP quantification and declaration

<Purpose>

Article 1

This document prescribes quantification and declaration of Carbon Footprint of Products (hereinafter called "CFP") under the CFP Communication Program (hereinafter called "the CFP Program") operated and managed by JEMAI (Japan Environmental Management Association for Industry).

<Outline of CFP quantification and declaration>

Article 2

- (1) The businesses that wish to make a CFP declaration of a product under the CFP Program shall conduct CFP quantification of the company's own product, and shall create a CFP declaration draft, pursuant to the requirements hereinafter prescribed and the applicable Product Category Rule of CFP (hereinafter called "CFP-PCR").
- (2) After passed the verification prescribed by JEMAI for the CFP quantification results and the CFP declaration draft described in the preceding paragraph (1), they are approved that they are conform to applicable approved CFP-PCR and relative rules. Then, by conducting a set of procedures of registration and release of CFP declaration and by making a license agreement of CFP mark, the businesses can make a CFP declaration.

<Requirements>

Article 3

Requirements for CFP quantification and declaration shall be prescribed in "Requirements for CFP quantification and declaration" and applicable CFP-PCR.

<Verification related to CFP quantification result and CFP declaration draft> Article 4

- (1) The businesses that wish to make a CFP declaration shall conduct CFP quantification pursuant to relative rules and applicable CFP-PCR, and shall create a CFP declaration draft. This CFP quantification result and the CFP declaration draft shall be submitted to the secretariat (in JEMAI) as "application of CFP verification".
- (2) Rules on CFP verification shall be prescribed in "Rules on CFP verification".

Supplementary provisions

This document shall come to effect as from July 2, 2012.
